1) INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

Contract type: Consultancy and Services

Duration of assignment: 2 Months

Type: Individual/Firm

WWF Pakistan, founded in 1970, is Pakistan's largest independent conservation Non-Government Organization, with over 20 offices nationwide. WWF-Pakistan's mission is to conserve the country's vast biodiversity and natural resources. To this end, it works in food, climate & energy, freshwater, wildlife, forests, and oceans. Since its inception, WWF-Pakistan has implemented over 200 projects and programs in all the aforementioned thematic areas. WWF-Pakistan works closely with local and national partners, government, private partners, research, and communities. WWF-Pakistan has extensive experience in working with international donors.

Background of Project & Assignment:

Pakistan is among the top water crisis counties in the world and ranked 14 out of 17 among the high water-risk counties, with an average per capita water availability of 964 m3 per annum. In light of such scenarios, WWF-Pakistan has initiated a five-year project called "Scaling up Nature-based Solution for Implementing integrated water resources management and enhanced water security in Pakistan" with the financial support of the Foreign Commonwealth Development Office (FCDO) through the WWF-UK.

2) GENERAL CONDITIONS

3) PURPOSE

This assignment aims to provide training to the local communities of Kolai Palas (Kohistan) on value chain development for the selected Non-Timber Forest Products (NTFPs) and establish market linkages for the products for the establishment of

sustainable livelihood opportunities to marginalized communities of Kohistan by integrating nature-based solutions (NBS).

- Conduct inception meeting(s) with the WWF team and develop an understanding of the tasks and for the selection
 of the site
- Consultation with relevant govt departments about the scope of NTFPs and their marketing
- Desk review of the relevant literature related to the NTFPs in the local context;
- Submit a work plan with clearly defined activities and sub-activities required for the project's completion
- Conduct an initial visit to the selected sites for an understanding of local NTFPs and their marketing scope;
- Identify tools and accessories (Kits) for NTFP harvesting, packing, etc., and facilitate its procurement.
- Design a manual regarding the selected NTFPs having details from sustainable harvesting and management to marketing in Urdu and English languages;
- Conduct training for the selected community on the area-related NTFPs, from sustainable harvesting to marketing and management.
- Support in the establishment of market assessment and development of linkages;
- Share at least two draft reports before submission of a final comprehensive report;
- Submit the final assignment report

Approach & Methodology:

- Before the start of the activity, the consultant will provide a brief implementation strategy roadmap in the form of an inception report;
- All logistics, food, and accommodation will be bear by WWF-Pakistan, including the training cost and tools for the harvesting NTFPs and marketing process;

4) DELIVERABLES

Following is list of specific tasks:

- Submit a work plan with clearly defined activities and sub-activities required for the project's completion;
- Initial assessment report including a marketing plan and strategy
- Submission of manual;
- Conducting community training on NTFP;
- Submission of assignment report.

Responsibilities of WWF Pakistan's F&M team:

- Facilitate the consultant (s) in data collection from the seed multiplication plots.
- WWF-Pakistan will bear boarding, lodging, and traveling expenses. Remuneration will be provided to the consultant(s) as per agreement.
- WWF-Pakistan will accommodate the consultant(s) for travel from Project offices to the Project area/field and vice versa.
- WWF-Pakistan will provide necessary material required for any sort of quality and puroty testing during the period
- WWF-Pakistan will bear costs of designing and printing of material, if there.
- No additional or incidental costs will be borne by WWF-Pakistan

The BID submitted by the participant must be structured as per the below provided instructions:

 - **a) Description of the complete projects:** the list and general information about the complete projects, description of the role in the project, other accomplishments of the Consultant.
- 3) **Proposal outlining scope consultancy service-** Description of scope and working process, stages, deliverables, exclusions, conditions;
- 4) Provide template of already complete similar type of reports- the WWF-PAKISTAN may request additionally;
- 5) Service Provision Timeline Provide Detailed Work Plan as per Deliverable and TORs.
- 6) **Financial Proposal** the prices shall be provided in Pak Rs, the total price shall include all costs related to service provision including applicable taxes.

9) FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

The proposed prices shall be provided in PKR, the total price shall include all costs related to service provision including all Direct and Indirect taxes, Travel, Boarding & Lodging shall be based on actual receipt up to max Ceiling (If Any).

The consultant will submit the cost of the assignment in a lump sum, including all applicable taxes according to the Government of Pakistan and the Government of KP

The Payment Term: shall be defined by the contract to be concluded between WWF -Pakistan and the consultant.

10) EVALUATION PROCESS

Applicant's proposal shall be evaluated based on Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method. Under QCBS both technical and financial proposals shall be evaluated as per following criteria against a maximum score of 100 points.

- A) Technical Proposal (70%)
 - Detailed workplan
 - Expression of interest (EOI)
 - Company's Profile
 - Detailed methodology
- B) Financial Proposal (30%)
 - Detailed financial proposal which should be inclusive of all applicable taxes and out of pocket expenses. The financial proposal should follow a breakdown structure i.e., specifying cost(s) to each head and subhead
 - Company's registration certificate
 - NTN detail(s)
 - Any legal or technical certification required for the task
 - Audited Accounts Report (if available) of last FY

Note: Late/ incomplete submissions will not be accepted. Only three (03) top-ranked firms will be included in the comparative process

11) DOCUMENTATION AND CONFIDENTIALITY

All documents completed based on requirements of the present RFP shall be the property of the WWF-Pakistan, and shall not without the consent of the WWF-Pakistan be used, reproduced or made available to third parties beyond what is necessary in respect of the fulfilment of the Project. All documents issued and information given to the BIDDER shall be treated as confidential.

Total Estimated Budget Inclusive of All taxes is 348,870/- and max Ceiling for Out of Pocket expenses is 100,000/- on presentation of actual invoices.
