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1) INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

Contract type: Consultancy and Services

Duration of assignment: August 26th 2024-August 30th 2024

Type: Firm

Background of Project & Assignment:

WWF-Pakistan is currently implementing an eight-year project, the International Labour and Environmental Standards Application in Pakistan's SMEs (ILES), in collaboration with the International Labour Organization (ILO), funded by the European Union (EU). The project employs a two-pronged approach, aiming to improve environmental governance and compliance in the leather and textile sector to leverage the economic benefits of the European Union's Generalized Scheme of Preferences (GSP+). Under the project, an exposure visit is being organized for ILES stakeholders to observe best practices in the textile sector of Germany. For this, WWF-Pakistan intends to hire the "TUD Dresden University of Technology" to organize and coordinate meetings and site visits with public and private sector stakeholders who are leaders in the textile sector, sustainable development or green productivity in Germany.

2) GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1) The WWF-PAKISTAN reserves the right to reject or accept any proposal. The WWF-PAKISTAN reserves the right to proceed with the implementation of any Service, in whole or in part, as described in the Proposal.

3) PURPOSE

a. Objective of the Consultancy:

The purpose of this visit is to expose key Pakistani stakeholders to the best practices in the textile sector of Germany and to facilitate an exchange between the delegation members, their institutions, and various German ministries, regulators, industry practitioners, renowned research institutions, and service providers in the field of international cooperation for sustainable development.

b. Specific Tasks:

The scope of this consultancy involves organizing and coordinating meetings and site visits with public and private sector stakeholders who are leaders in the textile sector, sustainable development or green productivity in Germany for the duration of 26-30 August, 2024.

4) Deliverables

- For the duration of 26-30 August 2024, organize and coordinate meetings and site visits with public and private sector stakeholders who are leaders in the textile sector, sustainable development or green productivity in Germany.
- Site Visits: Participants will visit textile manufacturing facilities, recycling centers, and innovative
 enterprises that have successfully adopted sustainable and circular practices in Germany. These
 visits will provide real-life examples and practical insights into the implementation of
 sustainability initiatives in the textile sector.
- Workshops and Presentations: Expert-led workshops and presentations will be conducted to
 provide participants with in-depth knowledge and understanding of sustainability and circularity
 in the textile industry. These sessions will cover topics such as sustainable materials, recycling
 technologies, circular design, and closed-loop manufacturing. Interactive discussions and Q&A
 sessions will encourage active participation and knowledge exchange.
- Interactive Discussions: Participants will engage in facilitated interactive discussions and group activities to share experiences, challenges, and best practices. These discussions will enable participants to learn from each other's experiences and perspectives, fostering collaboration and generating innovative ideas for sustainable and circular textile practices in Pakistan.
- Policy Engagement: The study mission will include engagements with policymakers, industry
 experts, and relevant stakeholders of Germany. These interactions will provide participants with
 insights into the policy landscape and opportunities for collaboration. This will enable
 participants to contribute their perspectives and input into the development of effective policies
 and strategies for the textile sector in Pakistan

5) REQUIREMENTS

WWF-Pakistan intends to hire TUD Dresden for this assignment. The Centre for International Postgraduate Studies of Environmental Management (CIPSEM) is a renowned training facility within the Faculty of Environmental Sciences at TUD Dresden University of Technology. It has almost 50 years of experience conducting specialized training in environmental sustainability and climate change for experts and decision-makers from the Global South.

7) FORMAT OF THE PROPOSAL

The BID submitted by the participant must be structured as per the below provided instructions:

- 2) Experience:
 - **a) Description of the complete projects:** the list and general information about the complete projects, description of the role in the project, other accomplishments of the Consultant.
- 3) **Proposal outlining scope consultancy service-** Description of scope and working process, stages, deliverables, exclusions, conditions;
- 4) **Provide template of already complete similar type of reports-** the WWF-PAKISTAN may request additionally;
- 5) Service Provision Timeline Provide Detailed Work Plan as per Deliverable and TORs.
- 6) **Financial Proposal** the prices shall be provided in Pak Rs, the total price shall include all costs related to service provision including applicable taxes.

The proposed prices shall be provided in PKR, the total price shall include all costs related to service provision including all Direct and Indirect taxes, Travel, Boarding & Lodging shall be based on actual receipt up to max Ceiling (If Any).

The consultant will submit the cost of the assignment in a lump sum, including all applicable taxes according to the Government of Pakistan and the Government of KP

The Payment Term: shall be defined by the contract to be concluded between WWF -Pakistan and the consultant.

9) EVALUATION PROCESS

Applicant's proposal shall be evaluated based on Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method. Under QCBS both technical and financial proposals shall be evaluated as per following criteria against a maximum score of 100 points.

- A) Technical Proposal (70%)
 - Detailed workplan
 - Expression of interest (EOI)
 - Company's Profile
 - Detailed methodology
- B) Financial Proposal (30%)
 - Detailed financial proposal which should be inclusive of all applicable taxes and out of pocket expenses. The financial proposal should follow a breakdown structure i.e., specifying cost(s) to each head and subhead
 - Company's registration certificate
 - NTN detail(s)
 - Any legal or technical certification required for the task
 - Audited Accounts Report (if available) of last FY

Note: Late/ incomplete submissions will not be accepted. Only three (03) top-ranked firms will be included in the comparative process

10) DOCUMENTATION AND CONFIDENTIALITY

All documents completed based on requirements of the present RFP shall be the property of the WWF-Pakistan, and shall not without the consent of the WWF-Pakistan be used, reproduced or made available to third parties beyond what is necessary in respect of the fulfilment of the Project. All documents issued and information given to the BIDDER shall be treated as confidential.

11) BUDGET

Total Budget for this activity inclusive of all taxes and Out of Pocket expenses is **EUR 12,494/**-A draft version of the modules/curriculum will be submitted to WWF-Pakistan before the delivery of the training that include but is not limited to the topics of
