1) INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

Contract type: Consultancy and Services

Background of Project & Assignment:

As the World's leading packaging and processing company, Tetra Pak has been manufacturing and supplying aseptic dairy and juice beverage cartons in Pakistan since the past 40 years.

In line with its strategic ambition to lead the sustainability transformation, Tetra Pak aims to achieve its recycling targets by 2030. In the aftermath following Covid-19, the world has observed an increased stress on food supply chains and there is a rising need for innovative and integrated solutions to feed a growing population sustainably. To address this issue, as a member of the global Tetra Pak family, Tetra Pak Pakistan, is actively working to increase the recycling of Used Beverage Cartons (UBCs) so it continues to provide people with access to high quality and safe beverage items. To support Tetra Pak Pakistan in this endeavor, WWF-Pakistan, has been working to understand and strengthen the UBC value chain, evaluate recycling rates and establish contacts with more paper mills each year to upscale the recycling of UBCs in various scope cities of Pakistan. This report contains the results for the sampling and survey data gathered from field visits conducted for each scope city. Notably, it outlines UBCs quantities in the old, corrugated cartons and the mixed paper waste, including its collection and recycling quantities for all scope cities. Using this information, the report analyzes the feasibility to upscale UBCs recycling in Pakistan by providing recommendations and the way forward.

7) FORMAT OF THE PROPOSAL

The BID submitted by the participant must be structured as per the below provided instructions:

2) Experience:

- a) Description of the complete projects: the list and general information about the complete projects, description of the role in the project, other accomplishments of the Consultant.
- 3) **Proposal outlining scope consultancy service-** Description of scope and working process, stages, deliverables, exclusions, conditions;
- 4) Provide template of already complete similar type of reports- the WWF-PAKISTAN may request additionally;
- 5) **Service Provision Timeline** Provide Detailed Work Plan as per Deliverable and TORs.
- 6) **Financial Proposal** the prices shall be provided in Pak Rs, the total price shall include all costs related to service provision including applicable taxes.

8) FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

The proposed prices shall be provided in PKR, the total price shall include all costs related to service provision including all Direct and Indirect taxes, Travel, Boarding & Lodging shall be based on actual receipt up to max Ceiling (If Any).

The consultant will submit the cost of the assignment in a lump sum, including all applicable taxes according to the Government of Pakistan and the Government of KP

The Payment Term: shall be defined by the contract to be concluded between WWF -Pakistan and the consultant.

9) EVALUATION PROCESS

Applicant's proposal shall be evaluated based on Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method. Under QCBS both technical and financial proposals shall be evaluated as per following criteria against a maximum score of 100 points.

- A) Technical Proposal (70%)
 - Detailed workplan
 - Expression of interest (EOI)
 - Company's Profile
 - Detailed methodology
- B) Financial Proposal (30%)
 - Detailed financial proposal which should be inclusive of all applicable taxes and out of pocket expenses. The financial proposal should follow a breakdown structure i.e., specifying cost(s) to each head and subhead
 - Company's registration certificate
 - NTN detail(s)
 - Any legal or technical certification required for the task
 - Audited Accounts Report (if available) of last FY

Note: Late/ incomplete submissions will not be accepted. Only three (03) top-ranked firms will be included in the comparative process

10) DOCUMENTATION AND CONFIDENTIALITY
