Background of Project & Assignment:

The WWF- Pakistan is implementing a project namely "community disaster rescue centre in district Kot Addu, DG khan and Rajanpur in the southern part of the Punjab in Pakistan" to enhance the resilience and adaptive capacity of vulnerable and disaster-prone communities and wildlife rangers living in flood-prone areas. The WWF-Pakistan is committed to enhance disaster management capabilities through a comprehensive training program. Effective knowledge products are essential to this effort, providing learners with the necessary knowledge and skills to respond to disasters effectively. The WWF- Pakistan seeks to engage a consultancy firm/consultant to design and develop high-quality knowledge products tailored for a disaster management training program to strengthen communities against climate induced disasters in the southern part of the Punjab province in Pakistan. The consultancy will design a range of knowledge products, including first aid manuals for insect and snake bites, infographics, and videos, to strengthen the capacity of government departments and communities in disaster-prone areas, enhancing their understanding of first aid procedures and effective actions during disasters or floods

a. The objective of the Consultancy:

The primary objective of this consultancy to design and develop comprehensive first aid manuals and related materials for insect and snake bites, along with knowledge products and infographics, to educate communities and government departments on effective disaster preparedness, response strategies, and first aid measures.

b. Specific Tasks:

The specific tasks of the consultancy are

- Development of knowledge materials to educate communities and government departments on broader disaster preparedness and response measures.
- Designing of knowledge products aimed at educating communities and government departments on disaster preparedness and response strategies.
- Coverage of the Community Disaster Rescue Centre Project's closing event.
- A video showcasing the Community Disaster Rescue Project, highlighting its objectives and the impact on enhancing community preparedness and resilience at the project sites

4) Deliverables

a. Qualification

7) FORMAT OF THE PROPOSAL

The BID submitted by the participant must be structured as per the below provided instructions:

- 2) Experience:

a) **Description of the complete projects:** the list and general information about the complete projects, description of the role in the project, other accomplishments of the Consultant.

- 3) **Proposal outlining scope consultancy service-** Description of scope and working process, stages, deliverables, exclusions, and conditions;
- 4) **Provide template of already complete similar type of reports-** the WWF-PAKISTAN may request additionally;
- 5) Service Provision Timeline Provide Detailed Work Plan as per Deliverable and TORs.
- 6) **Financial Proposal-** the prices shall be provided in Pak Rs, the total price shall include all costs related to service provision including applicable taxes.

8) FINANCIAL PROPOSAL

The proposed prices shall be provided in PKR, the total price shall include all costs related to service

provision including all Direct and Indirect taxes, Travel, Boarding & Lodging shall be based on actual receipt up to max Ceiling (If Any).

The consultant / Firm / Company will submit the cost of the assignment in a lump sum, including all applicable taxes according to the Government of Pakistan and the Government of Punjab.

The Payment Term: shall be defined by the contract to be done between WWF-Pakistan and the consultant / Firm / Company.

9) EVALUATION PROCESS

Applicant's proposal shall be evaluated based on Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method. Under QCBS both technical and financial proposals shall be evaluated as per following criteria against a maximum score of 100 points.

A) Technical Proposal (70%)

- Detailed workplan
- Expression of interest (EOI)
- Company's Profile
- Detailed methodology

B) Financial Proposal (30%)

- Detailed financial proposal which should be inclusive of all applicable taxes and out of pocket expenses. The financial proposal should follow a breakdown structure i.e., specifying cost(s) to each head and subhead
- Company's registration certificate
- NTN detail(s)
- Any legal or technical certification required for the task
- Audited Accounts Report (if available) of last FY

Note: Late/ incomplete submissions will not be accepted. Only three (03) top-ranked firms will be included in the comparative process
