Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Work in close coordination with Project Manager and Coordinator to ensure effective communication, implementation and delivery of project activities.
- 2. Conduct field mobilization activities to engage and inform local communities about the project objectives, activities, and benefits.
- 3. Collect data and information through surveys and interviews to support project implementation and research activities.
- 4. Provide support in organizing meetings, workshops, stakeholder consultations, face-to-face discussions and clean energy trainings as per the project deliverables.
- 5. Mobilize and consult with the rural communities to understand their needs, preferences and concerns regarding the green trainings.
- 6. Maintain liaison and establish positive relationship with local communities, stakeholders, and relevant government authorities to foster partnerships and enhance project coordination.
- 7. Contribute to regular progress reporting and the preparation of reports and presentations on project activities and outcomes as per the requirement.
- 8. Monitor and report on the social impact of the project on local communities, including any challenges or concerns identified.
- 9. Assist in identifying opportunities for collaboration, partnerships, and capacity-building initiatives with local organizations and other institutions.
- 10. Provide logistical support, ensuring the availability of required equipment, materials, and resources at the site.
- 11. Any other work assigned by the supervisor

Selection Criteria

Candidate for the position should ideally have:

- 1. Bachelor's or Master's degree in social sciences, development studies, environmental sciences/engineering, or any related field.
- 2. 2-5 Years of proven experience in research, data collection, community engagement and capacity building preferably in rural development related projects.
- 3. Additional knowledge of solar installation and maintenance would be preferred
- 4. Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to effectively engage and communicate with diverse stakeholders.
- 5. Ability to work independently, as well as collaboratively in a team, and meet deadlines.
- 6. Knowledge of local cultural and social dynamics in Multan, Pakistan is an advantage.
